



APPLICATIONS FOR POSITIONS 2018-2019 SEASON

The Board of Bowls Taranaki seeks applications and/or expressions of interest for the following positions for next season. All positions are considered very important to the role that Bowls Taranaki plays in fostering and promoting bowls and liaising with its various stakeholders including clubs.

Bowls Taranaki President and vice-President: Nominations shall be in writing signed by the Club President and Club Secretary of the nominating Club and shall contain the consent of the nominee together with the nominee's full postal address and other information (such as CV) as the Board may request. Nominations for the positions of President and Vice-President may be made by any Club of any person who has served not less than two years as a Centre Board Member or at least two years as a Member of a Club Executive. **Nominations** close on May 1. Nomination forms are held by all club secretaries and the Executive Officer of Bowls Taranaki.

Bowls Taranaki Board (two positions): The board is made up of seven individuals, two are elected (president and vice president) and the other seven are appointed. Brien Bennett and Grant Hassall retire this year by rotation (as required by the constitution). The Board is responsible for the governance of bowls in Taranaki. **Applications** close on May 1. Application forms are held by all club secretaries and the Executive Officer of Bowls Taranaki.

Revital Fertilisers Taranaki representative selector (two positions, one for the men, one for the women): Responsible for selecting all the representative sides for the gender. **Applications** close on May 20. Application forms are held by all club secretaries and the Executive Officer of Bowls Taranaki.

Taranaki Open Fours committee: responsible for the running of the Open Fours, from collating entries, to organising the draw and managing the event. Following the retirement of the previous chairman, expressions of interest are sought from individuals for both the chairman's role and as well as the committee. **Expressions of interest** should be made to the Executive Officer by May 1.

Publicity Officer: responsible for the Centre's website, Facebook page, daily newsletters during the men's and women's open fours, newspaper reports and radio interviews. The role could be done jointly by two or more individuals. Following the retirement of the previous publicity officer, expressions of interest are sought from individuals for the role. **Expressions of interest** should be made to the Executive Officer by May 1.
